

13/03/2007 : MYEG to launch RTD range of e-services on April 1

MY E.G. Services Bhd (MYEG) together with the Road Transport Department (RTD) will launch a range of e-services that allow for the renewal of confirmed driving licences, the checking of Kejara points and the payment of RTD summonses via short messaging service (SMS) from April 1, 2007.

In a statement on March 13, the e-government e-services project concession holder said the public could renew their licences either via its e-services kiosks or through the MYEG portal online, receive free reminders via SMS before their licences expire and check their Kejara points via the portal.

The company also said it was holding talks with the RTD to make available the list of blacklisted drivers, which would allow the public to check the status before they attempt to renew their driving licences or vehicle road tax.

MYEG executive chairman Senator Datuk Dr Norraesah Mohamad said: "We are committed to working together with the government to enhance the public sector delivery system. We are focussed on providing services that will make it more convenient for the public to transact with the government agencies."
